# SitRep No. 1 for National and Local Elections (2022)

May 07, 2022 05:00 pm

The synchronized fully automated National and Local Elections (NLE) will be conducted on Monday, 09 May 2022 as mandated in Section 2 of RA 7166. Likewise, the ARMM elections were also synchronized with the 2019 NLE per RA 10153.

Further, gun ban is implemented from 09 January to 08 June 2022. Per COMELEC, during the election period, no person shall bear, carry or transport firearms or other deadly weapons in public places, including any building, street, park, private vehicle or public conveyance, even if licensed to possess or carry the same, unless authorized in writing by the Commission.

Special Weather Outlook for 2022 National Election (06 May 2022)

- The dominant weather system to affect the country during the conduct of National Election will be the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).
- Eastern Visayas and Mindanao will be generally cloudy skies with rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by the oscillation of the ITCZ. The rest of the country will have warm and humid weather conditions apart from isolated afternoon or evening rainshowers and thunderstorms.
- Light to moderate winds coming from the east and southeast will prevail over Luzon becoming light easterly to variable over Visayas and Mindanao. The coastal waters will be slight to moderate.
