## **Situational Report for PANUNUMPA 2022: Presidential Inauguration on 30 June 2022**

### **SitRep No. 1 PANUNUMPA 2022: Presidential Inauguration**

**June 30, 2022 02:00 pm**

The President-elect shall assume respective offices on 30 June, 12:00 noon following the election as mandated in Article VII Section 4 of the Philippine Constitution marking the commencement of the six-year term of a President of the Philippines.

Relative to this, the inauguration of the 17th President, Ferdinand Romualdez Marcos Jr., will be held in the National Museum of Fine Arts on 30 June 2022 to be attended by local, national, and international personalities.

#### **SPECIAL WEATHER FORECAST FOR INAUGURATION DAY**

- Southwest Monsoon is forecast to affect the City of Manila and the rest of Greater Metro Manila on Inauguration Day.
- Mostly cloudy to cloudy with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.
- Winds will be light to moderate from the southwest.

#### National



#### National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- Maintained its BLUE Alert Status on 29-30 June 2022
- Conducted coordination meetings and activated the Response Clusters to be on stand-by.
- Issued the following Memorandum
  - a. No. 85 A and 87 re National Incident Management Team (NIMT) for "PANUNUMPA" 2022 issued on 15 June 2022.
  - b. No. 86 re Response Clusters Activation for the Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (JTG EPR) for "PANUNUMPA" 2022 issued on 15 June 2022.
  - c. No. 88 re Task Groups (TGs) under the Joint Task Group Emergency Preparedness and Response (JTG EPR) for "PANUNUMPA" 2022 issued on 15 June 2022.

#### National Incident Management Team (NIMT)

- On 29 June 2022, at 7:00 AM, the send-off ceremony was held at the Rizal Park Open Auditorium. The Incident Management Team led by OCD provided guidance to the multi-agency resources to be deployed starting 29 June 2022 until 01 July 2022 to secure and ensure the safety of all attendees and participants of the Inauguration Ceremony.
- Established Incident Command Post and 5 staging areas (Rizal Park, Intramuros, PICC, Paco, Quiapo).
- A total of 53 teams / 291 personnel (TG Fire Safety and Suppression; TG CBRNE; TG Medical Emergency Management; TG SRR; NIMT) were deployed and prepositioned.
- A total of 397 assets and resources from BFP, PAF, PA, PN, DOH, LGU, PCG, and MMDA were prepositioned for medical emergency management, fire safety & fire suppression, SRR, CBRNE and IMT.
- Conducted task groups meetings and distribution of radios.



#### Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA)

Continuous monitoring of the weather situation and dissemination of Special Weather Forecast.



#### Department of Health (DOH)

##### HEMB-DOH CENTRAL

- Raised Code Blue Alert and sent a memorandum to CHD Metro Manila and all Medical Center Chiefs of Department of Health Retained Hospital of National Capital Region.
- Continuously close monitoring of any untoward incident.
- Provided assistance and support with CHD Metro Manila in terms of printing forms and other logistical support
- Provided assistance and support with OHCC OPCEN (OSCAR BASE) to reinforce fast coordination in the transmission of radio traffic control communication to the medical teams that are being deployed in the area.

##### DOH METRO MANILA

- Organized and main in-charged in the deployment of Health Emergency Response Teams (HERTs) in the different areas near the inauguration venue.

- Prepared and finalized logistical supplies such as IDs, Car Pass, and Stickers to be used in the upcoming event.
- Conducted intensive radio checks to all medical teams to be deployed in the area.
- Actively participated in the simultaneous exercise (SIMEX) in the preparation for the actual event.

- Established a virtual EOC at MMCMMC
- Established a communication Net for all MMDRRMC Resources
- Deployed 2 ambulance team at staging area 2 and 6 located at BFP Intramuros and Raha Sulayman respectively

### **Manila DRRMO**

- Prepositioned EPR resources in the surrounding vicinity of the National Museum of Fine Arts and at Plaza Del Carmen Staging Area 5
- Deployed 6 Ambulances with EMTs and a standby SAR Team
- Deployed 3 Ambulances with EMTs, SAR Rescue Truck with SAR Team, and a Fire Truck with crew for the concert at Mendiola.
- A total of 24 personnel, 5 team leaders and 5 vehicles were deployed in their area

### **Pasay DRRMO**

- Deployed EPR resources at the vicinity of PICC Forum, Star City Parking.
- Prepositioned 2 ambulances with medic and a SAR Team at PICC
- Established virtual EOC
- A total of 13 personnel, 3 team leaders and 3 vehicles were deployed in their area

### **San Juan DRRMO**

- Deployed EPR resources for STGEPR Staging area 1 located at Kartilya ng Katipunan
- Prepositioned 1 SORT Team and 2 Ambulance Team (ERN & SORT Ambulance)
- A total of 12 personnel, 3 team leaders and 3 Vehicles were deployed in their area

### **Mandaluyong DRRMO**

- Deployed EPR resources for STGEPR Staging area 3 located at Manila Police Station 5 (Quirino Grandstand)

- Prepositioned 1 SAR Team and 1 Ambulance
- A total of 11 Personnel, 2 team leaders and 2 Vehicles were deployed in their area

### **Navotas DRRMO**

- Deployed EPR resources for STGEPR Staging area 4 located at MPD Headquarters (within MPD Compound)
- Prepositioned 1 SAR Team
- A total of 3 Personnel, 1 team leader and 1 vehicle were deployed in their area

### **Makati DRRMO**

- Directed the DRRMC members to take preparedness action and be on standby for possible deployment
- Mobilize Barangays to manage traffic particularly in Kalayaan Ave., J.P Rizal Extension and Lawton Avenue to lessen traffic congestion which may affect the inauguration
