### **SitRep No. 1 for the Effects of Shear Line (2022)**

**December 26, 2022 11:00 am**

24 December 2022, 2AM

At 2:00 AM, a weather advisory for Shear Line was issued and it will bring heavy to intense with at times torrential rains over Eastern Samar and moderate to heavy with at times intense rains over the rest of Eastern Visayas.

At 11:00 AM, heavy to intense with at times torrential rains over Eastern Visayas and Dinagat Islands while moderate to heavy with at times intense rains over Zamboanga Peninsula and the rest of Visayas.

At 11:00 PM, moderate to heavy rains over Southern Palawan, Eastern Visayas, Surigao Del Norte including Dinagat Islands, Misamis Occidental, Camiguin, and Misamis Oriental while light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Zamboanga Peninsula, the rest of Caraga, the rest of Northern Mindanao and the rest of Visayas.

25 December 2022, 11AM

At 11:00 AM, moderate to heavy rains with at times intense rains over Southern Palawan, Eastern Visayas, Surigao Del Norte and Dinagat Islands while moderate to heavy rains over Zamboanga Peninsula, Northern Mindanao, and the rest of Caraga, and Visayas.

At 11:00 PM, moderate to heavy rains with at times intense rains over Eastern Visayas, Dinagat Islands, Surigao Del Norte, and Surigao Del Sur. Moderate to heavy rains over Southern Palawan, Zamboanga Peninsula, Northern Mindanao, the rest of Caraga and of Visayas.

26 December 2022

At 11:00 AM, moderate to heavy rains with at times intense rains over Eastern Visayas, Bohol, Caraga, Northern Mindanao, and Davao Oriental. Moderate to heavy rains over Palawan and the rest of Visayas and Mindanao.
