### **SitRep No. 2 for NAZARENO 2023**

**January 09, 2023 08:00 am**

The Feast of the Black Nazarene is celebrated every 9th day of January wherein millions of devotees all over the country observe and join the celebration. Traditionally, the Image of the Black Nazarene is paraded from Quirino Grandstand to the Minor Basilica of the Black Nazarene (Quiapo Church).

However, the traditional procession will not be possible, so this year, the celebration was dubbed as, NAZARENO 2023.

06 January 2023

The eastern section of Luzon and Visayas will have cloudy skies with light rains while the rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy skies with passing light rains.

07 January 2023

Bicol region, Eastern Visayas and the eastern section of Mindanao will have cloudy skies with rainshowers and thunderstorms. Metro Manila and the rest of the country will be mostly cloudy with isolated passing light rains.

08 January 2023

The eastern section of Visayas and Mindanao will have cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms while Metro Manila and the rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy with passing light rains

09-13 January 2023

Bicol region, Visayas and Mindanao will have cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming frequent rains over the Bicol region and Eastern Visayas due to the expected approach of a low pressure system. Flash flood and landslides are expected. Metro Manila and the rest Luzon will be partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated passing light rains.

**National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)**

- Maintained BLUE ALERT Status since COVID-19 response operations.
- Monitored and ensured the dissemination of Rainfall, Gale Warning, Weather Advisories, and General Flood Advisories to all concerned RDRRMCs/OCDOs through SMS, NDRRMC website, and official social media websites for further dissemination to its respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs).

- Continuously coordinating with Local Government Units thru their respective Local Social Welfare and Development Office (LSWDO) and with Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) for reports on incidents requiring augmentation assistance from the FO-NCR.

January 8, 2023

Walk of faith terminated at 0346H with an estimated crowd of 43,000

**PASAY CITY**

- Pasay City DRRMO Operations Center was raised the alert level status to Red effective January 6, 2023 8AM until January 10, 2023 8AM.
- Prepared and assigned manpower and response vehicles for on-call Emergency Preparedness and

## **QUEZON CITY**

- Maintains 24/7 monitoring with 10 duty personnel.
- Disseminates timely advisories and PAGASA bulletins through social media account.
- Monitoring of localized thunderstorms and isolated rains.
- Monitoring the churches and praying stations within QC AOR.
- On-going coordination with 142 barangays for monitoring.
- Issuance of YELLOW alert status effective January 6, 2023, 8AM.
- Continuous Operation of QC IMT on COVID-19 transport, deployment of one (1) ambulance per district situated in satellite offices, and all QC USAR is on-standby alert.

## **MANILA CITY**

- Manila Disaster Operations Center closely monitoring the CCTV for possible emergency situation.
- Prepositioning of all assets in preparation for "Feast of Black Nazarene 2023".
- 24-Hour Heightened monitoring.
- Manila DRRMO personnel are posting weather updates.
- Manila DRRMO preposition its portalets located at Quirino Grandstand and Quaipo Church.
- Manila DRRM personnel conducted an operations briefing.
- Conducted operations briefing together with Manila Police District, Philippine Coast Guard and member from the Supreme Court.
- Logistical preparation of the procession such as road safety, electrical lighting, stage sanitation such as portalets, trash disposal.
- Security, peace and order of processional routes through its police force.
- Coordination with the National Parks Authority for the use of the Quirino Grandstand and Grounds.
- Coordination of the MDRRMC with NDRRMC for mitigation/prevention measures before and during the procession.
- Supervise the implementation of this IMPLAN.
- Ensure the safety of all responders and the general public within the period of SEÑOR NAZARENO 2023.
- Provide medical support if necessary.
- Provide Fire and Rescue services.
- Establish Emergency Operations Center located at 4th floor Manila City Hall Building.
- Manila Disaster Emergency Operation Center (MDEOC) is on Red Alert (highest monitoring) starting 1800H of January 6, 2023.
- 24/7 monitoring of weather conditions and other emergencies through telephone, internet, cellphone, etc. by the Disaster Response Management, Quick Response Team and Manila Disaster Emergency Operations Center.
- Monitor all the activities pertaining SEÑOR NAZARENO 2023.
- Follow all minimum health standards and guidelines at all time.
- Document and provide timely and responsive updates/situational reports to the Responsible Official and concern agencies.
- Establish Incident Command Post at Quirino Grandstand.
- Establish Incident Management Team.
- Establish Staging Areas at Bonifacio Shrine (Kartilya ng Katipunan) and in Manila DRRM Office – Quirino Base
- Weather assessment for the period of SEÑOR NAZARENO 2023.
- Responded to one (1) medical emergency and transported patient to Ospital ng Maynila
- Issued Executive Order No. 1 Series of 2023 entitled "Suspension of Work and Classes in All Levels in The City Government of Manila on 09 January 2023, to Allow Devotees to Participate in the Activities for the Feast Day of the Black Nazarene" and Executive Order No. 2, Series of 2023 entitled, "Liquor Ban from January 07-09, 2023 for the Peaceful Conduct of the Feast of Black Nazarene"
- Closure of Quezon Blvd. Road along Quezon bridge and C. Palanca Street effective from January 7-9, 2023 every 7:00PM onwards, parts of Rizal Avenue, Recto Avenue, Evangelista Street, Quezon Bridge, Espana Blvd., McArthur bridge, Padre Burgos Avenue, C. Palanca Avenue, Recto Avenue, Nicanor Reyes Street, Lerma Street, and A. Mendoza Street.
- 24/7 monitoring of weather conditions and other emergencies through telephone, internet, cellphone, etc. by the Disaster Response Management, Quick Response Team and Manila Disaster Emergency Operations

Center.

- Medical Standby at Kartilya Base and Quirino Grandstand.
- Assembling mini-Hospital at Kartilya ng Katipunan.
- Manila DRRM Office attending “Translacion Briefing”.
- Manila DRRM Office personnel assisting BFP Manila in Establishing Location for Units
- Continuous monitoring of “Walk of Faith thru CCTV and Medical Standbys.
- As of 0401H “Walk of Faith” Ended.
- As of 0852H Manila DRRM Office monitoring on situation at Quiapo Church thru CCTV
- Deployed 374 personnel from PNP, LGU, Volunteer Groups and other concerned offices within the vicinity of Quiapo and other strategic areas;
- Deployed 22 Rescue Ambulance, 14 Fire Trucks, 2 Rescue Trucks;
- Manila DRRMO coordinated with Philippine Red Cross for Medical Assistance

## **DILG NCR**

- Issued a Regional Memorandum to its field offices to monitor and report situation relative to the Feast of the Black Nazarene and to cause the widest dissemination of the MMDRRMC Memo No. 01 s. 2023.
- Directed DILG Manila Field Office to activate their EOC and advice the LGU of Manila to put their EOC on Red Alert status starting January 6-10, 2023.
- Deployed duty officers to closely monitor the peace and order situation of the Nazareno 2023.
- A total of 5,777 PNP personnel will be deployed to ensure peace, security and public safety during the said feast.
- Accomplishing the monitoring template shared through the Google Drive to report the disaster and peace and order situations and preparedness and response actions undertaken by the City of Manila Local Government.
- The monitoring template will be accomplished every 12:00 PM and 10:00 PM from January 6-10, 2023.
- PNP personnel will be deployed.
