**SUBJECT :** ACTIVATION AND STANDBY STATUS OF RESPONSE  
CLUSTERS ICOW MAYON VOLCANO UNREST

Alert Level 3 is raised over Mayon Volcano, with its relatively high level of unrest, and an increased tendency towards a hazardous eruption. Based on the current prevailing wind pattern, ash fall events may most likely occur on the south side of the volcano, and heavy rainfall could generate channel-confined lahars and sediment-laden streamflows.


In line with this, the following response clusters are hereby activated or placed on standby effective **June 11, 2023 (Sunday), 8:00 AM** to monitor and facilitate emergency response and humanitarian assistance in response to the effects of the volcano's unrest.
