SUBJECT : RESUMPTION OF FACE-TO-FACE CONDUCT OF NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL

The protracted COVID-19 pandemic has prevented the effective conduct of preparedness and response exercises and drills. While innovative approaches through webinars and limited physical interactions have been implemented by the NDRRMC through the OCD for the past two years in order to prevent the spread of the COVID virus, the said methods in conducting the Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills were obviously not that effective in testing and validating contingency plans as well as in assessing and enhancing preparedness for response at all levels and sectors.

The projected devastation and impacts of major earthquakes both to humans and properties dictate the continuance of regular promotion and conduct of simulation exercises with the aim of minimizing disaster risks. This is in line with our compliance with the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (SFDRR) Priority for Action 4 and the National DRRM Plan 2020-2030 Outcome 9, specifically Activity 9.2.3.

With a relatively decreasing COVID-19 cases nationwide from February 2022 to date per DOH's online COVID-19 Tracker, and pursuant to the issuance of the updated Alert Level Systems for COVID-19 by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) on June 4, 2022, the conduct of traditional or in-person Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill is hereby allowed. Provided that minimum health protocols such as, but not limited to, handwashing and social distancing are strictly implemented as much as practicable, to ensure effective, efficient, and safe implementation of NSED. Provided further, implementing agencies and offices shall designate Safety and Health Officers who will ensure, monitor, and

evaluate the proper implementation and strict observance of minimum public health standards throughout the exercise.

However, this is without prejudice to the authority of the IATF-EID to prohibit mass gatherings in any or all areas of the country should the circumstances call for it. In this case, the conduct of NSED shall be postponed or canceled or the methodology should be modified accordingly.

Further, the active participation of DRRMCs at all levels, including the Barangay DRRMCs, as well as the National Government Agencies and other Government entities is strongly encouraged.

In view thereof, the schedule for the CY 2023 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill is hereby disseminated:
