MAINTAINING OF NDRRMOC BLUE ALERT STATUS ICOW

TROPICAL DEPRESSION (TD) "AMANG"

Based on the Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 1 by DOST-PAGASA issued on 11 April 2023, 5:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Catanduanes developed into TD "AMANG". The center of TD "AMANG" was estimated based on all available data at 475 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (13.3°3N, 128.6°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center, and gustiness of up to 55 km/h. It is moving west northwestward at 20 km/h. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) No. 1 is in effect in Catanduanes, the northern portion of Eastern Samar, and the eastern portion of Northern Samar.

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert effective 11 April 2023.
