MAINTAINING OF NDRRMOC BLUE ALERT STATUS ICOW

LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) AND SHEAR LINE

Based on the Weather Advisory by DOST-PAGASA issued on 05 January 2023, 11:00 PM, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 530 km West of Coron, Palawan or 130 km Eas Northeast of Pagasa Island, Palawan (11.4°N, 115.4°E), while the effects of Shear Line and Northeast Monsoon will bring moderate to heavy with at times intense rains over Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, Aurora, Quezon, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Norte. Meanwhile, light to moderate with at times heavy rains will be experienced over Metro Manila, Cagayan Valley, CAR, MIMAROPA, the rest of CALABARZON, the rest of Visayas, the rest of CARAGA, Nueva Ecija, and Bulacan.

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert effective 05 January 2023 in connection with the LPA and Shear Line.
