DOWNGRADING OF NDRRMOC ALERT STATUS FROM

RED TO BLUE ICOW SUPER TYPHOON "EGAY"

The alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) in connection with Super Typhoon "EGAY" is hereby downgraded from RED to BLUE effective 09 August 2023 (Wednesday), 5:00 PM, in consideration of the following:

- STY "EGAY" has exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility on 28 July 2023, 8:00 AM. Per DOST-PAGASA's Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 35F for TC EGAY, the center of the eye of EGAY is located at 315 km West Northwest of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR).
- 2. Deactivation of select National Response Clusters (SRR, LAO, and ETC) ICOW STY "EGAY"

The NDRRMOC shall still continuously monitor the effects of the Southwest Monsoon enhanced by TCs "EGAY" and TY "FALCON" as well as the ongoing response operations with regard to Mayon Volcano Activity and Oil Spill incident in Oriental Mindoro.
