: PREPARATIONS FOR THE NATIONWIDE TRANSPORT STRIKE

ON 20 - 22 NOVEMBER 2023

A Nationwide Transport Strike will be conducted by the group Pagkakaisa ng mga Samahan ng Tsuper at Operator Nationwide (PISTON) on 20 - 22 November 2023 as to protest the implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program thereby, phasing out of some jeepneys. This strike led to the suspension of face-to-face classes and shifting online as announced by several Local Government Units, schools, and universities in the country.

In this regard, all are hereby directed to continuously undertake the following proactive measures to ensure the safety ad productivity of our community during this period:

- a. Closely monitor the developments related to the Nationwide Transport Strike, including its impact on transportation services, public safety, and public order.
- b Ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices, including police, transport authorities, and local government units, to maintain order and address any emerging issues effectively.
- c. Disseminate timely information to the public regarding the status of transportation, any road closures, and alternative routes.
- d. Ensure that public announcements are clear and easily accessible through various communication channels, including social media and official websites.
- e. Submit regular reports on the current situation and any untoward incidents to the NDRRMOC thru the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard.
