SUBJECT

Downgrading of Heightened Monitoring ICOW the Combined Effects of Shear Line and Low Pressure Area (LPA) and Magnitude 6.8 Earthquake in Sarangani. Dayao

Occidental.

In reference to the situation updates and status of response operations and coordination within the concerned regions and local government units affected by the combined effects of Shear Line and Low Pressure Area, and Magnitude 6.8 Earthquake in Sarangani, Davao Occidental, the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded effective 11 December 2023 (Monday). However, the NDRRMOC shall maintain its BLUE ALERT status to continuously monitor the situation in the country ICOW the Magnitude 7.4 and 6.8 earthquakes in Surigao del Sur, and maintain close coordination with relevant offices.

Furthermore, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard, email address ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph; telephone nrs. 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr. 8911- 1873.
