SUBJECT : RAISING OF NDRRMOC RED ALERT STATUS ICOW SUPER TYPHOON "MAWAR"

At 1:00 PM, 26 May 2023, Super Typhoon "MAWAR" was estimated based on all available data at 1,765km east of Central Luzon (outside PAR) with maximum wind / gust of 215 / 260 kph while moving westward at 20 kph. During the Weather Update and PDRA Analyst Group Meetings, "MAWAR" may enter the PAR region tonight or tomorrow early morning. It is forecasted to reach its peak intensity of 220 km/h within 24 hours and may slightly weaken but remain as a Super Typhoon until Monday morning as it moves towards the waters east of Extreme Northern Luzon. "MAWAR" will continue to weaken into a Typhoon by late Monday evening or Tuesday due to unfavourable conditions.

In this regard, the Alert Status at the **National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)** is raised to **RED** effective **26 May 2023 (Friday)** to closely monitor, consolidate, and report all related incidents and to ensure prompt coordination with concerned agencies and offices.
