MAINTAINING NDRRMOC BLUE ALERT STATUS ICOW

RAISING OF MAYON VOLCANO ALERT LEVEL TO 3 (INCREASED TENDENCY TOWARDS A HAZARDOUS

ERUPTION)

On 08 June 2023, 5:00 AM, DOST-PHIVOLCS issued a Mayon Volcano Bulletin raising its Alert Level from 2 (increasing unrest) to Alert Level 3 (increased tendency towards a hazardous eruption). Also, per the latest Mayon Volcano Bulletin as of 09 June 2023, 8:00 AM, the Mayon Volcano Network recorded six (6) dome-collapse Pyroclastic Density Currents (PDC) that lasted three (3) to six (6) minutes and 199 rockfall events based on seismic and visual observations.

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert effective 09 June 2023.
