MAINTAINING OF NDRRMOC BLUE ALERT STATUS ICOW

TROPICAL DEPRESSION (TD) "DODONG"

Based on the Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 1 by DOST-PAGASA issued on 13 July 2023, 10:00 PM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Aurora developed into TD "DODONG". As of 10:00 AM today, 14 July 2023 the center of TD "DODONG" was estimated based on all available data is in the vicninty of Allcapan, Cagayan (18.2°3N, 121.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center, and gustiness of up to 75 km/h. It is moving north northwestward at 15 km/h. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) No. 1 is in effect in Cagayan, Isabela, Apayao, Kalinga, Abra, Mountain Province, Ifugao, Benguet, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, and the northern portion of Pangasinan.

In this regard, the alert status at the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) is hereby maintained to BLUE Alert effective 14 July 2023.
