



Effects of Oil Spill in MIMAROPA and Region VI (Western Visayas)

SitRep No. 7 for the Effects of Oil Spill in MIMAROPA and Region VI

March 10, 2023 08:00 am

On 28 February 2023, 4:16 AM, MT Princess Empress was reported half submerged at vicinity waters off Naujan, Oriental Mindoro with 20 men onboard and loaded with 800,000 liters of Industrial Fuel Oil. At 4:20 AM, the stranded crews were rescued by MV EFES, a foreign vessel, and have been reported to be in good physical condition.

On 01 March 2023, MT Princess Empress was declared totally submerged by the PCG Team upon negative sightings of the said vessel during a seaborne and aerial search.

The Search and Rescue Team of Coast Guard Sub Station Calapan together with Special Operations Unit (SOU) Oriental Mindoro and Marine Environmental Protection Unit (MEPU) proceeded to the area of the incident to locate the submerged vessel. However, the operation was unsuccessful due to inclement weather conditions.

Further, Coast Guard Station Oriental Mindoro coordinated with the owner of the submerged vessel for the actions to be undertaken regarding the incident. An aerial inspection was also conducted around the vicinity of the incident. Upon the conduct of the said inspection, a visible oil sheen in the vicinity waters of Oriental Mindoro was sighted in the area.

On 05 March 2023, oil slick sightings were reported to have reached the Islands of Quiniluban and Agutaya in the Municipality of Agutaya, Palawan.

The RDRRMC MIMAROPA and VI conducted oil containment and collected oil waste on the shores in the following affected areas:

MIMAROPA

1. 46 sacks of contaminated sea weeds and 80 liters of oil were collected in the vicinity waters of Oriental Mindoro.
2. 20 drums of oil were collected (20 drums in Liwagao Island and 10 drums in Sabang Island).

REGION VI

1. Sitio Liwagao, Barangay. Sibolo, Liwagao Island, Caluya, Antique - An estimated of 2 KM length of coastline with estimated 8,000 liters or more of oily waste on the shores and collected 600 liters of oily water.
2. Sitio Sabang, Barangay. Tinogbog, Semirara Island, Caluya, Antique - An estimated 4 KM length of coastline with estimated 8,000 liters or more of oily waste on the shores and collected 2,500 liters of oily water collected while 343 sacks of sea grass (oily waste collected) and 8 (1 tonner-bags) of garbage contaminated with oil (oily waste collected)
3. Barangay. Semirara, Semirara Island, Caluya, Antique -An estimated 2 KM length of coastline with estimated 8,000 liters or more of oily waste on the shores and collected 400 liters and 88 sack of oily waste.
