Situational Report for the Observance of Holy Week (Semana Santa) (2023)

SitRep No. 1 for the Observance of Holy Week (2023)

April 03, 2023 05:00 pm

The Lenten Season or Semana Santa is a part of the liturgical year for Roman Catholics around the world in which different celebrations are observed. It starts with the commemoration of the fasting of Christ for 40 days in the desert and avoiding any temptation from Satan and culminates with the Easter Sunday and known as the greatest feast of the church year. Since Philippines is a Roman Catholic majority nation, this is a significant annual religious observance.

As commonly called, the Holy Week starts from the Sunday before the Easter, it is observed with the followers waving a palm branch symbolizing the arrival of Jesus in Jerusalem thus named the Palm Sunday. The Lent ends with the resurrection of Christ from the dead in the Easter following his Crucifixion by the Romans. This is celebrated with a festive event usually done during a mass at the dawn with portrayal of the Risen Christ meeting His mother, Mary. And for the kids, Easter egg hunt events are done by the church and private groups.

Filipinos commemorate this event with several ways. Aside from going to the church and attending mass, Filipinos also do "pabasa", Visita Iglesia, "Senakulo" and processions among others. Pabasa is a Catholic devotion wherein the followers continuously read the Pasyon, a 16th century epic poem which tells the life, passion, and death of Jesus Christ. This is done by Filipinos to repent their sins and to seek forgiveness from Christ. It also done as a meditation and devotion to the Catholic faith.

Meanwhile, Visita Iglesia is another Lenten celebration by visiting at least 7 different churches on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday often as a devotion by the followers. "Senakulo" or procession plays relieves the Passion of Jesus Christ during his trial, suffering and death. In some parts of the Philippines, (e.g., San Fernando, Pampanga), they actually crucify the one that portrays as Jesus with real nails. Due to this, UNESCO recognized this rite in Pampanga as an Intangible Cultural Heritage.
