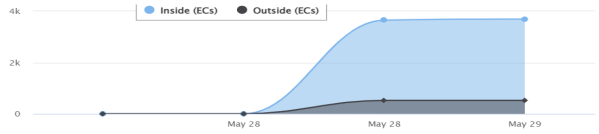

Situational Report for TC BETTY (2023)

SitRep No. 3 for TC BETTY (2023)

May 29, 2023 08:00 am

20 May 2023

-At 3:00 AM, a Tropical Cyclone Outside PAR was located 2,510 km East of Northern Mindanao (6.4°N, 149.0°E).
-At 3:00 PM, the TC developed as Tropical Storm MAWAR (2302) and was located 2,525 km east of Northeastern Mindanao (6.0°N, 149.1°E) with an almost stationary movement.

21 May 2023

-At 4:00 PM, MAWAR developed into a Severe Tropical Storm and was located at 2,390 km East of Northeastern Mindanao (7.5°N, 148.0°E) and has 100 km/h maximum sustained winds. Gustiness is traveling at up to 125 km/h and 10 km/h in a North-northwesterly direction.

22 May 2023

-At 3:00 AM, MAWAR developed to a Typhoon and was located at 2,330 km East of Mindanao (8.3°N, 147.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 km/h near the center and gustiness up to 160 km/h moving West-northwestward at 15 km/h.

23 May 2023

-At 3:00 PM, MAWAR developed into a Super Typhoon (STY) and was located at 2,285 km East of Visayas (11.8°N, 146.4°E) with maximum sustained winds of 185 km/h moving Northward at 15 km/h.

24 May 2023

-At 11:00 PM, Typhoon "MAWAR" moves past the Northern Mariana Islands while maintaining its strength with maximum sustained winds of 185 km/h near the center moving Northwestward slowly.

25 May 2023

-Super Typhoon "MAWAR" further intensifies over the Philippine Sea with maximum sustained winds of 205 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 250 km/h, and central pressure of 910 hPa moving westward at 20 km/h.

26 May 2023

-At 11:00 AM, "MAWAR" slightly intensifies while moving westward over the Philippine Sea with maximum sustained winds of 215 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 260 km/h, and central pressure of 905 hPa.

27 May 2023

-At 2:00 AM, STY "MAWAR" entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was named "BETTY". It has a maximum sustained winds of 195 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 240 km/h, and central pressure of 915 hPa. BETTY is forecasted to remain as a super typhoon over the weekend.

-At 11:00 AM, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) No. 1 is raised over The eastern portion of Cagayan including Babuyan and Camiguin Islands and the eastern portion of Isabela.

-At 11:00 PM, "BETTY" weakens into a typhoon as it continues to move over the Philippine Sea. It has a maximum sustained winds of 175 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 215 km/h, and central pressure of 935 hPa.

TCWS No. 1 is raised over Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, Apayao, Ilocos Norte, the northern and central portions of Abra, Kalinga, the eastern and central portions of Mountain Province, the eastern and central portions of Ifugao, the northern and central portions of Aurora, Quirino and the northeastern portion of Nueva Vizcaya.

28 May 2023

-At 5:00 AM, TY "MAWAR" maintains its strength while moving over the Philippine sea east of northern Luzon.

-At 5:00 PM, TY "BETTY" slightly weakens and is now moving west northwestward over the Philippine Sea east of northern Luzon. TCWS No. 1 is still raised over Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, Apayao, Ilocos Norte, the northern and central portions of Abra, Kalinga, the eastern and central portions of Mountain Province, the eastern and central portions of Ifugao, the northern and central portions of Aurora, Quirino and the northeastern portion of Nueva Vizcaya.

29 May 2023

-At 5:00 AM, TY "MAWAR" slightly accelerates northwestward over the waters east of Cagayan.

TCWS No. 2 is raised over Batanes, the eastern portion of Babuyan Islands (Babuyan Is., Camiguin Is., Didicas Is., Pamuktan Is.), and the northeastern portion of mainland Cagayan (Santa Ana).

TCWS No. 1 is raised over the rest of Babuyan Islands, the rest of mainland Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino, the northeastern portion of Nueva Vizcaya (Kasibu, Quezon, Solano, Bagabag, Diadi, Villaverde, Bayombong, Ambaguio), Apayao, Abra, Kalinga, Mountain Province, Ifugao, Ilocos Norte, the northern and central portions of Aurora (Dilasag, Casiguran, Dinalungan, Dipaculao, Baler), Polillo Islands, the northern portion of Catanduanes (Caramoran, Viga, Gigmoto, Panganiban, Bagamanoc, Pandan), the northeastern portion of Camarines Sur (Caramoan, Garchitorena, Lagonoy, Tinambac, Siruma), and the northern portion of Camarines Norte (Vinzons, Paracale, Jose Panganiban, Capalonga, Talisay, Daet, Mercedes, Basud)
