

SitRep No. 1 for the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (2023)

October 29, 2023 08:00 am

The Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (BSK) represent the smallest units of government in the Philippines, and an election is scheduled for October 30, 2023, to select their officials. These elections are of paramount significance, as they will determine the leaders of the smallest political and administrative units in the Philippines, the barangays. Barangay officials play a pivotal role in the provision of basic services and the resolution of community disputes. Sangguniang Kabataan officials, on the other hand, represent the interests of the youth in the barangays.

Each Barangay is led by a barangay captain, which serves as the chief executive, and is composed of 7 Barangay Council Members and 1 Barangay Youth Council Representative (SK Chairperson). There are a total of 42,027 barangays across the country.

Simultaneously, elections will be held for the reformed Sangguniang Kabataan (youth council), which has a structure similar to the Barangay Council. Youth aged 15 to 30 years will choose an SK chairperson, who will also be a member of the Sangguniang Barangay, along with 7 SK councilors in their respective barangay.

Originally scheduled for May 2022, the elections were rescheduled to December 2022 due to the enactment of RA 11462 in July 2019. This extension of the B/SK officials' term to 5 years was deemed necessary by the legislative branch to provide more time for project implementation. In June 2022, RA 11935 was enacted, moving the BSK elections to October 2023.

Winners of the 2023 BSK elections will serve until 2025, with subsequent elections held every three years.

- c. Loading of cargoes must commenced first, followed by embarkation of passengers.
- d. Vessel representative must inform the PCBSI personnel on duty in relaying the message that the vessel is ready for passengers boarding/embarkation thru VHF radio.
- e. PCG on duty and vessel representative must take charge of the actual counting of passengers for boarding to avoid overloading.
- Observe the limitation of rolling cargoes at the marshalling area.
- Observe and implement segregation scheme (prioritization of cargoes)
- -Passengers from buses and door to door private vehicles must:
- a. Undergo individual inspection and body frisking before entering the PTB.
- b. Utilize the PTB.
- c. Standby inside PTB and wait for PCBSI announcement of their boarding time.

- d. Shipping Lines must limit their accommodation for their walk-in.
- Shipping lines must issue tickets to passengers within the vessel capacity for the easy counting of PCG and to avoid delay departure time. Temporarily suspend online booking for the whole duration of OPLAN.
- Queuing of Cargoes Outside the Port:
- a. Coordinate as to which is to be loaded first.
- b. Secure the safety and security of all vehicles outside the port or at the national road to avoid complaints from vehicle owners of overtaking and loss of their valuables.

- e. Jointly implement the inspection of vehicles loaded and empty before entering the port premises. There must be proper coordination with the vehicle owner to avoid misundertanding between them and the enforcers.
