## **Situational Report for Undas (2023)**

### **SitRep No. 2 for Undas (2023)**

**November 01, 2023 08:00 am**

All Saints' Day and All Soul's Day are celebrated by Filipinos every 01 November and 02 November of the year to pay respect to beloved dead relatives and friends. On this annual commemoration, locally termed "UNDAS", millions are expected to travel back to their respective provinces and expected to flock cemeteries around the country in observance of Undas 2023.

#### **SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR UNDAS 2023 (issued 27 October 2023)**

The Northeast Monsoon (Amihan), Shear Line, and a possible occurrence of a Low-Pressure Area (LPA) will be the dominant weather systems to affect the entire archipelago during the "Undas" event.

By Monday until Tuesday (October 30-31), Bicol Region, Visayas, Caraga, and Quezon province will be cloudy with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to the combined effects of Shear Line and LPA. Cagayan Valley and Cordillera Administrative Region will be mostly cloudy with light rains, while Metro Manila, Central Luzon, and Ilocos Region will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated light rains due to Northeast Monsoon. The rest of the country will have isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms mostly in the afternoon or evening.

By Wednesday until Friday (November 1-3), Quezon, Bicol Region, and Eastern Visayas is expected to be cloudy with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to combined effects of Shear Line and LPA. Floods and landslides are possible in low lying and in mountainous areas due to prolonged rains. Cagayan Valley and Aurora will have mostly cloudy skies with light rains, while Ilocos Region, the rest of Central Luzon, and Metro Manila will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rains due to Northeast Monsoon. The rest of the country will have isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms mostly in the afternoon or evening.

Moderate to strong winds coming from the Northeast will prevail over Northern Luzon and the coastal waters will be moderate to rough, while light to moderate northeasterly to northwesterly winds will affect the rest of the country with slight to moderate sea.

**National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)**

- Maintained Blue Alert Status at the NDRRM Operations Center per NDRRMC Memorandum No. 135 s. 2023 dated 18 October 2023.

**Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)**

-The DSWD Central Office (CO), Field Offices (FOs), and National Resource Operations Center (NROC) have stockpiles and standby funds amounting to ₱2,406,805,636.30 with breakdown as follows:

- CSWDD staff assisting the lessees.

### **3. MANILA CITY**

- At 0800H 30 October 2023, the Parañaque DRRMO ELO Center joined the MMDRRMC Virtual Emergency Operations Center (VEOC) for the monitoring of Barangay & SK elections 2023 and Undas 2023.
- MASG district I and II deployed personnel in Memorial Park and cemeteries for safety and security.
- CENRO conducted mopping and clearing operations along Manila Memorial Park, Loyola Memorial Park, Himlayang Palanyag, and Catholic Cemetery.
- PNP deployed at the entrances of Memorial Park and cemeteries.
- BFP deployed fire trucks and ambulances.
- TPMO deployed personnel along major roads near cemeteries and memorial park. No reported/monitored heavy traffic situations and incidents.
