**TO :** ALL CONCERNED NDRRMC MEMBER-AGENCIES AND REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS

**SUBJECT :** Maintaining of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status to RED ICOW the TYPHOON "OFEL" and TROPICAL STORM "MAN-YI" (Local Name "PEPITO")

Based on DOST-PAGASA Tropical Cyclone Bulletin as of 13 November 2024, 5:00 PM, Typhoon "OFEL" was estimated at 480 km East of Baler, Aurora (15.7°N, 126.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 120 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 150 km/h, and central pressure of 975 hPa. Its present movement is west northwestward at 25 km/h. "OFEL" is forecasted to move west northwestward to northwestward over the Philippine Sea before making landfall along the eastern coast of Cagayan or Isabela tomorrow (14 November) afternoon.

Meanwhile, as of 13 November 2024, 11:00 AM, Tropical Storm "MAN-YI" was estimated at 1,965 km east of Eastern Visayas (Outside PAR) (12.3°N, 143.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 80 km/h, and central pressure of 998 hPa. Its present movement is west southwestward at 30 km/h. MAN-YI is forecast to intensify into a severe tropical storm today within 24 hours and reach typhoon category by tomorrow afternoon or evening.

In this regard, the following measures shall be implemented:

- a. Continue with the operational coordination of the NDRRMC Inter-Agency Coordinating Cell (IACC).
- b. Maintaining of the RED Alert Status of the NDRRMOC effective **13 November 2024**.
- c. Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) and representatives from **AFP, BFP, PCG, PNP, DOST-PAGASA, DILG, DSWD, DA, DPWH, DepEd, DOH, PIA, DOTR, DOTR-PPA, MMDA, DOE, DTI, PMS, OES and COA** are required to continue rendering of duty at the NDRRMOC to ensure continuous coordination and provide necessary information and related requirements. Likewise, document and report all pertinent information on the ongoing situation, actions taken, and any significant developments.

Likewise, all NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and to send updates to NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: [ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph](mailto:ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph), telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
