SUBJECT : Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and
Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert
Status from BLUE to RED effective 24 May 2024 ICOW
Tropical Depression "AGHON"

Based on the DOST-PAGASA Tropical Cyclone Bulletin issued at 02:00 pm, 24 May 2024, Tropical Depression "AGHON" slightly intensifies as it moves westward. AGHON is forecast to move generally west northwestward to northwestward from today until tomorrow while slowly intensifying. On the track forecast, AGHON is forecast to make a close approach or make landfall in the vicinity of Eastern Visayas tomorrow morning as a Tropical Storm (TS). Afterwards, AGHON will pass north northwestward over Eastern Visayas, then emerge over the waters off the east coast of Bicol Region tomorrow evening as a TS. On Sunday, AGHON will begin recurving generally northeastward or north northeastward over the waters east of Luzon while starting to continuously intensify. Current forecast scenario shows intensification into a Severe Tropical Storm (STS) by Sunday morning and into a typhoon by Monday.

In this regard, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from BLUE to RED effective 24 May 2024, 5:00 PM. Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC.

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and to send update to NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
