ADVISORY ON ROCKET LAUNCH OF THE LONG MARCH 7A BY THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

The People's Republic of China is scheduled to launch the Long March 7A from the Wenchang Spacecraft Launch Site in Wenchang, Hainan sometime between 1700H-2300H on 21-25 August 2024. Parts of this Long March 7A rocket are expected to drop within the identified drop zone which is approximately 38 NM (DZ 1) away from Burgos, Ilocos Norte and 66 NM (DZ 2) away from Sta Ana, Cagayan.

In this connection, the following actions are recommended related to Marine Access out of an abundance of caution between 1700H-2300H on 21 – 25 August 2024:

- a) PCG, BFAR, DILG, and DENR-NAMRIA are advised to consider temporary restrictions and the issuance of Notice to Mariners, Coastal Navigational Warnings or NAVAREA XI warnings, as applicable, in the identified drop zones.
- b) Concerned RDRRMCs I and II are required to continue monitoring and submit updates on this event.
