On September 01, 2024, Tropical Depression "ENTENG" has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and is expected to cause flash floods or landslides due to moderate to intense rains in various regions of the country including Eastern Visayas, MIMAROPA, and NCR.
