SUBJECT : Downgrading of the National Disaster Risk Reduction
and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert
Status from RED to BLUE effective 31 May 2024 ICOW
Tropical Cyclone "AGHON"

In reference to the situation updates and status of response operations and coordination within the concerned regions and Local Government Units affected by Typhoon "AGHON", the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded from RED to BLUE effective 31 May 2024, 8:00 AM taking the following consideration:

1. Typhoon "AGHON" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).
2. NDRRMC Response Clusters have been deactivated
3. The situation in the regional level is manageable.

The NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with concerned offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
