Maintaining of Alert Status of the National Disaster

Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center

(NDRRMOC) to BLUE ICOW Kanlaon Volcano

Based on the DOST-PHIVOLCS Volcano Bulletin issued on 03 June 2024, 8:00 PM, the alert level for Kanlaon Volcano was raised from Alert Level 1 to Alert Level 2. This means that there is current unrest driven by shallow magmatic processes that could eventually lead to further explosive eruptions or even precede hazardous magmatic eruption. The public is strongly advised to be vigilant and avoid the four (4) kilometer-radius Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) to minimize risks from sudden explosions, rockfall and landslides.

In this regard, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby maintained to BLUE effective 04 June 2024 in connection with the Kanlaon Volcano eruption.

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and to send update to NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: ndrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
