SUBJECT : Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and  
Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert  
Status from BLUE to RED effective 21 July 2024 ICOW  
Tropical Storm (TS) "CARINA" and Southwest  
Monsoon

Based on Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) Core Group Meeting conducted on 21 July 2024, TS "CARINA" was estimated based on all available data at 545 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.7 °N, 127.2 °E ) with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 80 km/h, and is moving Northwestward at 20 km/h. TS "CARINA" may also reach the Severe Tropical Storm (TS) category and may enhance the Southwest Monsoon.

In this regard, the **alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from BLUE to RED effective 21 July 2024, 6:00 PM**. Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, PNP, and respective technical staff from DOST-PAGASA are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC.

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and to send update to NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: [ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph](mailto:ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph), telephone nrs.: **8912-5668, 8912-3046**; and/or facsimile nr.: **8911-1873**.
