SUBJECT : Downgrading of the National Disaster Risk Reduction
and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert
Status from RED to BLUE effective 06 August 2024,
8:00 AM ICOW Southwest Monsoon and Tropical
Cyclone "CARINA"

In consideration of the situation updates and current status of response operations and coordination within the concerned regions and Local Government Units affected by Typhoon "CARINA", the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded from **RED to BLUE effective 06 August 2024, 8:00 AM** in view of the following factors:

1. Southwest Monsoon has weakened on 26 July 2024, 11:00 PM, per Weather Advisory No. 34 of DOST PAGASA and TC "CARINA" exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on 25 July 2024, 11:00 PM.
2. Deactivation of Selected NDRRMC Response Clusters and activation of Early Recovery Cluster ICOW TC "CARINA".
3. The situation in the regional level is manageable.

Likewise, Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP are still required to render duty at the NDRRMOC, while all other member-agencies are requested to join the Virtual Emergency Operations Center via Zoom.

The NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with concerned offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: **8912-5668, 8912-3046**; and/or facsimile nr.: **8911-1873**.
