SUBJECT

Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status from WHITE to RED effective 01 September 2024 ICOW Tropical Depression (TD) "ENTENG" and

Southwest Monsoon

Based on Pre-Disaster Risk Asessment (PDRA) Core Group Meeting conducted on 01 September 2024, TD "ENTENG" was estimated based on all available data at 100 km Northeast of Catarman, Northern Samar or 115 km East Southeast of Virac, Catanduanes (13.0°N, 125.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 70 km/h, and central pressure of 1000 hPa, and is moving Northwestward at 15 km/h.

In this regard, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from WHITE to RED effective 01 September 2024, 5:00 PM. Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, PNP, and respective tehnical staff from DOST-PAGASA, DILG, DSWD, DA, DPWH, DepEd, and DOH are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC effective 02 September 2024, 8:00 AM.

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and to send update to NDRRMOC thru the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
