**TO : CONCERNED NATIONAL RESPONSE CLUSTERS LEADS**

**SUBJECT : ACTIVATION AND STANDBY STATUS OF RESPONSE CLUSTERS ICOW THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (located based at 440 km East of Casiguran, Aurora)**

A Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 460km East of Casiguran, Aurora. With this, and the Southwest Monsoon which brings occasional to frequent rains, flooding, and rain-induced landslides are likely, especially in areas highly or very susceptible to these hazard maps and regions with significant antecedent rainfall.

The following Response Clusters are hereby placed on standby and activated effective 15 September 2024 (Sunday) at 7:00 PM to monitor preparedness for response activities, facilitate emergency risk communication, and provision humanitarian assistance in response to the effects of the said LPA:
