SUBJECT

: Enhancement of Disaster Operations

Following the After-Action Review conducted for the Combined Effects of Southwest Monsoon, TD Butchoy, and STY Carina on 14 August 2024, a set of recommendations has been established. These recommendations collectively aim to elevate the effectiveness of the Council's DRRM services hence, designated in-charge must take appropriate action:

Discuss the guidelines and protocols in reporting to harmonize the data and establish reporting mechanisms including timelines and official sources of information.	NDRRMC Member Agencies
Finalize the reporting protocols of the Debris Clearing and Civil Works Cluster for affected roads and bridges.	DPWH
Shelter Support and Assistance	
Craft and revise policies to ensure adequate provision of emergency shelter support and assistance taking into account the other assistance provided by other memberagencies.	DHSUD
Forecasts and Advisories	
Include a comparative analysis of past tropical cyclones with the prevailing weather system during PDRA Analyst Group Meetings / Weather Updates as reference for assessment and decision-making.	DOST-PAGASA
Issue a separate advisory for the Tullahan River in response to the recent flooding incident.	DOST-PAGASA
Risk Communication Mechanisms	
Enhance the mechanism for risk communication and craft the Operational Guidelines for the Crisis Communication Cluster	Crisis Communication Cluster
No Build Zones	
Reiterate the Memorandum Circular No. 2024- 074 regarding Preparedness Measures of Local Government Units for the impending La Niña and Rainy Season CY 2024. This includes the guidance for no build zone in high-risk areas.	DILG

Coordinate with River Basin Management to discuss flood mitigation activities in Metro Manila and nearby areas.	DOST-PAGASA
Community Trainings

Provisions of R.A. 10121	
Review and ensure the implementation of NDRRMC-DILG-DBM JMC 2013-1 and NDRRMC-DILG-DBM-CSC JMC 2014-1.	NDRRMC Member AgenciesDILGDBMCSC
