SUBJECT : Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and
Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert
Status from BLUE to RED effective 30 September 2024
ICOW Typhoon (TY) "JULIAN"

Based on Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 17, issued on 30 September 2024, 8:00 AM, the center of the eye of Typhoon JULIAN was estimated over the coastal waters of Balintang Is., Calayan, Cagayan (19.9°N, 122.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 175 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 215 km/h, and central pressure of 940 hPa. It is moving west northwestward at 10 km/h and is nearing Super Typhoon Category.

In this regard, the **alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from BLUE to RED effective 30 September 2024, 12:00 NN**. Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, PNP, and respective technical staff from DOST-PAGASA, DILG, DSWD, DA, DPWH, DepEd, and DOH are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC **effective 01 October 2024, 8:00 AM**.

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to monitor their respective AORs and to send update to NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph, telephone nrs.: **8912-5668, 8912-3046**; and/or facsimile nr.: **8911-1873**.
