In consideration of the situation updates and current status of response operations and coordination within the concerned regions and Local Government Units affected by TC "JULIAN", the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded from **RED to BLUE effective 07 October 2024, 6:00 PM** in view of the following factors:

- Tropical Cyclone "JULIAN" has exited PAR based on the Tropical Cyclone Bulletin No. 35F of DOST-PAGASA issued on 04 October 2024, 11:00 AM
- 2. Deactivation of selected NDRRMC Response Clusters and activation of Early Recovery Cluster ICOW TC "JULIAN".
- 3. The situation in the regional level is manageable.

Likewise, Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from **AFP**, **BFP**, **PCG**, **PNP**, and **DOST-PAGASA** are still required to render duty at the NDRRMOC, while all other member-agencies are requested to join the Virtual Emergency Operations Center via Zoom.

The NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with concerned offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: <u>ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph</u>, telephone/facsimile nrs.: **8912-2665** and **8911-1873**.
