TO : CONCERNED NATIONAL RESPONSE CLUSTER LEADS AND MEMBERS

SUBJECT : ACTIVATION AND STANDBY STATUS OF RESPONSE CLUSTERS ICOW TD "KRISTINE"

On October 21, 2024, at 9:00 AM, Tropical Depression "KRISTINE" was estimated based on all available data at 890 km East of Eastern Visayas with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h, gustiness to 70 km/h, and moving west-southwestward at 30 km/h. It is also expected that highest Wind Signal which may be hoisted during the occurrence of KRISTINE is Wind Signal No. 4.

With this, the following NDRRMC Response Clusters are hereby activated and/or placed on standby status effective October 22, 2024 (Tuesday), 8:00 AM to monitor and facilitate needed emergency response and humanitarian assistance:
