SUBJECT: Raising of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and

Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status from BLUE to RED ICOW Tropical Cyclone

"MARCE" effective 05 November 2024, 6:00 AM

On 04 November 2024, 11:00 AM, the center of Tropical Storm "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 775 km East of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (12.4°N, 132.5°E) with maximum s ustained winds of 75 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 90 km/h, and central pressure of 998 hPa. It is moving west northwestward at 35 km/h.

In this regard, the alert status at the NDRRMOC is hereby raised from **BLUE** to **RED** effective 05 November 2024, 6:00 AM. Likewise, the Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from AFP, BFP, PCG, PNP, and respective representatives from **DOST-PAGASA**, **DILG**, **DSWD**, **DA**, **DPWH**, **DOH**, **DOE**, **DepEd**, **PIA**, **DOTr**, **DOTr-PPA** are hereby required to render duty at the NDRRMOC and are expected of the following:

Provide necessary information and related requirements to the NDRRMOC.
Likewise, document and report all pertinent information on the ongoing situation, actions taken, and any significant developments.

 Represent respective agency in briefings and meetings and keep Department Secretaries/Agency Heads informed on relevant matters discussed in meetings. When needed, notify respective agency officials of any emergency council meetings or press conferences requiring attendance

 Ensure effective coordination with the OCD and other DDOs at the NDRRMOC, handling sensitive information responsibly by adhering to confidentiality protocols and preventing unauthorized access to critical data

Further, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and RDRRMCs are required to continue monitoring their respective AORs and send updates to NDRRMOC thru the NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard, email address: <a href="mailto:ndrmoc@ocd.gov.ph">ndrmoc@ocd.gov.ph</a>, telephone nrs.: 8912-5668, 8912-3046; and/or facsimile nr.: 8911-1873.
