Subject : **Deactivation of the NDRRMC Inter-Agency Coordinating Cell on 21 November 2024**

The NDRRMC IACC will be deactivated on 21 November 2024. Moving forward, the National Response Cluster, under the leadership of DSWD, will assume full responsibility for coordinating all National Response Clusters including Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD), Logistics (OCD), Search, Rescue, and Retrieval (AFP), Health (DOH), Law and Order (PNP), Emergency Telecommunications (DICT), Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD), Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD), Education (DepEd), Debris Clearing and Civil Works (DPWH), Crisis Communication (PCO-PIA), and Shelter (DHSUD).

The National Response Cluster shall work closely with other relevant government agencies to efficiently and effectively address the needs of affected communities.
