DEACTIVATION OF RESPONSE CLUSTERS ICOW

TROPICAL CYCLONES "NIKA", "OFEL" and

"PEPITO"

With Tropical Cyclone PEPITO now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and a continuous decrease in evacuees and requests for augmentation from regional DRRMCs related to the effects of Tropical Cyclones NIKA, OFEL, and PEPITO, the following National Response Clusters are hereby deactivated effective November 26, 2024, 5:00 PM.

Deactivated:

- 1. Logistics (OCD)
- 2. Food and Non-Food Items (DSWD)
- 3. Search, Rescue and Retrieval (AFP)
- 4. Health (DOH)
- 5. Law and Order (PNP)
- 6. Emergency Telecommunications (DICT)
- 7. Internally Displaced Persons Protection (DSWD)
- 8. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (DSWD)
- 9. Education (DepEd)
- 10. Debris Clearing and Civil Works (DPWH)
- 11. Crisis Communications (PCO-PIA)
- 12. Shelter (DHSUD)

Concerned cluster lead agencies are advised to continue monitoring response and early recovery activities at regional and local levels, providing augmentation as needed.
