AND REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS

**SUBJECT :** Downgrading of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and  
Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC) Alert Status  
from RED to BLUE ICOW the Tropical Cyclones (TCs)  
“OFEL” and “PEPITO” effective 26 November 2024, 6:00  
PM

In consideration of the situation updates the heightened monitoring of the NDRRMOC shall be downgraded from **RED to BLUE** effective **26 November 2024, 6:00 PM** in view of the following factors:

1. TC “PEPITO” exited PAR on 18 November 2024.
2. Deactivation of the NDRRMC Response Cluster effective 26 November 2024, 5:00 PM.
3. The situation in the regional level is manageable.

Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) from **AFP, BFP, PCG, and PNP** are still required to render duty at the NDRRMOC. Further, the Virtual Emergency Operations Center (via Zoom) shall no longer remain active on a continuous basis but may be reactivated as necessary for coordination. All concerned regional offices, agencies and other stakeholders shall be duly notified of any reactivation.

Likewise, the NDRRMOC shall continuously monitor the situation in the country and maintain close coordination with concerned offices. Thus, concerned NDRRMC Member-Agencies and Regional DRRMCs are still required to continue monitoring and submit updates on the current and recent disaster events to the NDRRMOC thru the **NDRRMC Monitoring Dashboard**, email address: [ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph](mailto:ndrrmoc@ocd.gov.ph), and telephone/facsimile nrs.: **8911-1406, 8912-2665**, and **8911-1873**.
