MARCH 12 AND LONG MARCH 3B BY THE PEOPLE'S

LONG MARCH 12

The People's Republic of China is scheduled to launch the Long March 12 from the Hainan International Commercial Launch Center in Wenchang, Hainan sometime between 2000H-2400H on 30 November – 05 December 2024. Parts of this Long March 12 rocket are expected to drop within the identified drop zone which is approximately 28 NM away from Rozul Reef, and 108 NM away from Quezon, Palawan.

The estimated drop zone coordinates and summary of information are as follows:

II. LONG MARCH 3B

The People's Republic of China is scheduled to launch the Long March 3B from the Xichang Satellite Launch Center in Liangshan Yi Autonomous Prefecture, Sichuan sometime between 1400H-1600H on 03 – 05 December 2024. Parts of this Long March 3B rocket are expected to drop within the identified drop zone which is approximately 112 NM away from Rozul Reef, and 151 NM away from Busuanga, Palawan.

The estimated drop zone coordinates and summary of information are as follows:

In this connection, the following actions are recommended related to Marine Access out of an abundance of caution between abovementioned dates:

- a) PCG, BFAR, DILG, and DENR-NAMRIA are advised to consider temporary restrictions and the issuance of Notice to Mariners, Coastal Navigational Warnings or NAVAREA XI warnings, as applicable, in the identified drop zones.
- b) Concerned **RDRRMC MIMAROPA** is required to continue monitoring and submit updates on this event.

PhilSA cautions everyone against retrieving or coming in close proximity to these materials to minimize risk from remnants of toxic substances such as rocket fuel. Personnel protective equipment (PPE) is recommended when contact with the debris is necessary.

The public is advised to immediately inform local authorities of any suspected debris sighted at sea or land.
