MAINTAINING OF THE NDRRMOC ALERT STATUS TO

BLUE ICOW THE YEAR-END CELEBRATION 2024

In observance of the year-end celebration / holiday season, during which a significant number of Filipinos are expected to travel across the country for celebrations and activities, and in light of the continued alert status and activity of Kanlaon Volcano, the NDRRMOC Alert Status shall remain on BLUE Alert. Accordingly, continuous monitoring efforts shall be sustained and heightened. For reporting and documentation purposes, the monitoring period for holiday-related incidents shall cover 23 December 2024 to 02 January 2025.

Furthermore, Detailed Duty Officers from the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), and Philippine National Police (PNP) are hereby directed to render duty at the NDRRMOC to ensure uninterrupted coordination and to facilitate requests and address concerns pertinent to your respective agencies.
