SitRep No. 02 for Black Nazarene Traslacion 2024

January 09, 2024 08:00 am

The Feast of the Black Nazarene is celebrated every 9th day of January wherein millions of devotees all over the country observe and join the celebration. Traditionally, the Image of the Black Nazarene is paraded from Quirino Grandstand to the Minor Basilica of the Black Nazarene (Quiapo Church).

This year, the traditional procession (Traslacion) is returned, resulting for number of devotees expected to gather and participate in the said procession.

SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE BLACK NAZARENE 2024 (08-10 January 2024)

Issued: 05 January 2024

The Northeast Monsoon (Amihan), Shear Line, and Easterlies are the dominant weather systems that will affect the country within the outlook period.

By Monday until Wednesday (January 8-10), Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, and Quezon will experience cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by Shear Line. Mostly cloudy skies with light rains is expected over Cagayan Valley, Apayao, Kalinga, and Aurora, while partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains will be experienced over Metro Manila, Ilocos Region, the rest of Cordillera Administrative Region, and CALABARZON due to Amihan. The rest of the country will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms mostly in the afternoon or evening due to prevailing Easterlies.

- Raised Code White Alert in the NCR and disseminated the copy to all Directors of Center for Health Development and UHC Health Service Cluster Area II (NCRSL II).

- Continuous monitoring of any untoward incident.

DSWD NCR

- DSWD-NCR has established its emergency operation center at Room 109, DRMD Office, DSWD-NCR, Sampaloc, Manila starting January 6, 2024.
- The Field Office-NCR, through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD), conducts daily monitoring through telephone, internet, cell phone, etc.;
- The DRMD renders 24/7 duty in the virtual emergency operation center of the Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) starting January 6, 2024 for BNT;
- The DRMD, through its DROMIC Team, is assigned to prepare situational reports as necessary and
- The FO-NCR is continuously coordinating with local government units through their respective Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) and with the Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) for reports on incidents requiring augmentation assistance from the FO-NCR. As of this reporting time, no request for any augmentation has been received by the FO.

QUEZON CITY

- Maintains 24/7 monitoring with ten (10) duty personnel
- Disseminates timely advisories and PAGASA bulletins through social media account: <https://www.facebook.com/qcdrmmc/>
- Monitoring of localized thunderstorms and isolated rains.
- Monitoring the situations of churches and praying stations.
- Conducted phone brigade to one hundred forty-two (142) BHERT to monitor untoward events in their AOR.
- Issued a YELLOW alert status for heightened monitoring effective at 1200H on January 08, 2024.

CDRRMC Manila City

- Manila Disaster Emergency Operations Center (MDEOC) is on Blue Alert.
 - Closed monitoring on MDEOC weatherboard.
 - 24/7 monitoring of weather conditions and other emergencies through telephone, internet, cellphone, etc. by Disaster Response Management, Quick Response Team and Manila Disaster Emergency Operations Center.
 - All Manila DRRM Office assets and manpower are prepositioned for possible deployment if deemed necessary.
 - Ensure the safety of all responders and the general public within the period of Feast of the Black Nazarene 2024.
 - Provide medical support if necessary and follow all minimum health standards and guidelines at all times.
 - Document and provide timely and responsive updates/situational reports to responsible offices.
 - Provide fire and rescue services if necessary.
 - Monitoring all the activities of the Feast of the Black Nazarene 2024.
 - Conducted mass casualty incident exercise at Kartilya ng Katipunan.
 - Manila DRRM Personnel established Field Hospital to be used to cater patient for the period of Feast of the Black Nazarene located at Bonifacio Shrine (Kartilya ng Katipunan).
 - Establish an Incident Command Post (ICP) at Bonifacio Shrine (Kartilya ng Katipunan)
 - Establish an Emergency Operations Center located on the 4th Floor of the Manila City Hall Building.
 - Manila Police District personnel deployed at Manila Disaster Emergency Operations Center to monitor the situation.
 - Manila Bureau of Fire Protection personnel deployed at Manila Disaster Emergency Operations Center to monitor the situation.
 - CGK9 Team Malacañang conducted paneling and inspection within the vicinity of Ayala, Mc Arthur, and M.L. Quezon Bridge.
 - Establishment of Field Hospital to be used to cater patient for the period of Feast of the Black Nazarene located at Bonifacio Shrine (Kartilya ng Katipunan).
 - Manila Disaster Operations Center closely monitoring the CCTV for possible emergency response.
 - Standard protocols were strictly implemented to ensure the public safety.
- On about 0608H January 6, 2024 CGK9 Team Malacañang conducted paneling and inspection within the

vicinity of Ayala, Mc Arthur and M.L. Quezon Bridge.

- Provide daily flushing, misting and fogging operations.
- Established Medical Post at Quirino Grandstand to monitor also the situation in "Pahalik" activity.
- Manila DRRM personnel monitoring of "Pahalik" activity at Quirino Grandstand.
- Officers of OCD-NCR visited the Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office Command Center.
- Officers of OCD-NCR visited the Incident Command Post (ICP) and Field Hospital at Kartilya ng Katipunan.

As of January 8, 2024

- Conducted Command and General Staff meeting together with EOC Manager led by the Incident Commander, Arnel Eustacio Angeles.
- Monitor the crowd estimate at Quiapo Church and Quirino Grandstand. Personnel from the Manila DRRM Office checked in at the Multi-Agency Coordinating Center of Quiapo Church to monitor the situation in Quirino Grandstand and Quiapo Church.
- Manila DRRMO Medical team is on standby alert for medical and emergency assistance.
- The Philippine Coast Guard Malacañang conducted Paneling and inspection within the vicinity of Quirino Grandstand, Katigbak Parkway.
- The Philippine Coast Guard K9 conducted paneling and inspection within the vicinity of Ayala, McArthur and M.L. Quezon Bridge.
- The Philippine coast guard Malacañang Conducted under water paneling and inspection to McArthur Bridge, Ayala Bridge, M.L. Quezon Bridge and Jones Bridge.
- As of 0600H, PCGK9-EOD team 2 conducted random paneling and inspection within the vicinity of Quirino Grandstand, katigbak parkway and south road with no found result.
- As of 0807H, The Philippine Coast Guard Malacañang CGK9 Malacañang
- conducted paneling and inspection within the vicinity of Ayala, McArthur and M.L. Quezon Bridge with no found result.
- Philippine General Hospital Doctors check-in at Incident Command Post.
- A total of 3 High-Speed Response Boats, 4 Small Boats, 2 Jet skis, and 3 boat Platforms from the Philippine Coast Guard have been deployed, supplementing the security efforts.
- In collaboration with the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), an additional 1 Ferry Boat and 4 Speed Boats have been stationed strategically to enhance safety measures along the river.
- The Philippine Red Cross has generously contributed to the efforts by deploying 3 Floating Assets to assist in ensuring the safety and security of all participants.
- The PCG urges all participants and attendees to cooperate with the deployed authorities, adhere to safety protocols, and remain vigilant throughout the event.
