SitRep No. 1 for the Observance of Holy Week (Semana Santa) 2024

March 27, 2024 08:00 am

The Lenten Season or Semana Santa is a significant annual religious observance for the Filipino Roman Catholics. It begins on Palm Sunday and continues on through Eastern Sunday. During this season, people go to churches to attend mass to reflect and offer prayers.

Also, Catholics observe Spanish-influenced rituals such as processions, passion plays (senakulo), and pabasa. It is also an opportunity for families to spend time together.

Eastern Sunday culminates the celebration of Semana Santa, viewed as the greatest feast of the Church year. It is one of the most festive events, a day of joy, and celebration for the faithful commemorating Jesus Christ's resurrection from the dead.

SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK ON THE OBSERVANCE OF SEMANA SANTA 2024 (25 -31 March 2024)

The Easterlies will be the dominant weather system to affect the country throughout the outlook period.

On 25 March 2024, Easterlies will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas and Caraga. This weather condition will gradually move northward, affecting the provinces of Quezon and Aurora by Tuesday (26 March). Meanwhile, Metro Manila and the rest of the country will be partly cloudy to cloudy, with the possibility of isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

For the rest of the outlook period (27 - 31 March), generally fair weather condition is expected over the whole country apart from isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms mostly over the eastern section.

The public is advised to lessen their physical outdoor activities between 12:00 to 4:00 in the afternoon when temperatures are at their highest. Otherwise, drink water regularly, stay and rest in shaded areas from time to time, and wear light-colored clothing to avoid experiencing fatigue, heat cramps and heat exhaustion.

National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- Issued Memorandum No. 027, s. 2024 dated 15 March 2024 re: Raising of the Alert Status to Blue at the NDRRMOC from 22 March 2024 to 2 April 2024 ICOW the Observance of the Holy Week (Semana Santa) 2024.



Department of Health (DOH)

- Activated Code White Alert for Holy Week 2024 from 24 March 2024 until 31 March 2024.
- Through Health Emergency Management Bureau (HEMB), the DOH continues to conduct active monitoring.
- All DOH Centers for Health Development (CHDs) in the regions are coordinating with their respective Regional or Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, especially in tourist attractions and religious areas.

Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)

The DSWD Central Office (CO), Field Offices (FOs), and National Resource Operations Center (NROC) prepositioned stockpiles and standby funds amounting to ₱2,409,565,560.12 with breakdown as follows:

a. Standby Funds

A total of ₱388,547,264.48 standby funds in the CO and FOs. Of the said amount, ₱315,058,355.22 is the available Quick Response Fund (QRF) in the CO.

b. Stockpiles

A total of 1,214,479 family food packs (FFPs) amounting to ₱844,759,615.15, other food items amounting to ₱360,908,589.27, and non-food items (FNIs) amounting to ₱815,350,091.22 are available.

DSWD DRMG

- The Disaster Response Management Bureau (DRMB) closely coordinates with DSWD FOs for significant disaster response updates relative to the Observance of Semana Santa 2024.
- DRMB closely coordinates with DOST-PAGASA for significant updates and other related information relative to the Observance of Semana Santa 2024.
- All DRMB Quick Response Team (QRT) members and emergency equipment are on standby and ready for deployment.
- NRLMB ensures the replenishment and availability of FNIs for resource augmentation to DSWD FOs as the need arises.

OCD RO2/Cagayan Valley RDRRMOC

- Conducted PDRA Core Group Meeting re Preparation for the Observance of the Lenten Season 2024 on 20 March 2024.
- Issued CVDRRMOC Memorandum No 34 re Raising of Alert Status at the CVDRRM Operations Center to BLUE ALERT from 22 March 2024 to 2 April 2024

Department of the Interior and Local Government Region 2

- Issued DILG MC No. 2024-034 re Ensuring a Safe and Peaceful Observance of Semana Santa 2024 on 15 March 2024
- Mandates all Local Chief Executives to:
 - o Convene their respective LPOC and LDRRMC for action planning and preparing for heavy movement of people, focusing on ensuring adequate, safe and orderly public transport and medical services;
 - o Deployment and mobilization of law and traffic enforcers and auxiliary forces and medical personnel (road/traffic management, and other local hotspots);
 - o Ensure safety in terminals, churches and other public areas; and
 - o Implement other measures necessary or as applicable in their respective LGUs.
- Mandates PNP and BFP to:
 - o Be on full alert and coordinate with and provide necessary assistance to LGUs in enforcing measures to ensure a safe and peaceful Semana Santa 2024;
 - o BFP is also directed to continue its awareness campaign in the communities and ensure preparedness measures in case of fire emergencies, consistent with the observance of Fire Prevention Month.

Department of Social Welfare and Development Field Office 2

- The Field Office 02 has stockpile and standby funds totaling P123,765,859.10 with breakdown as follows:
 - o A total of P5,000,000.28 standby fund is available at the Field Office 02.
 - o The Field Office 02 has a total stockpile of 39,414 Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to ₱26,108,812.97; 12,905 Non-Food Items (NFIs) and other Non-Food Items amounting to ₱32,841,281.50; and 249,139 food and other food items amounting to ₱3,122,738.95 which are available in the region. Moreover, a total of 35,263 FFPs amounting to ₱24,415,852.52 and 16,230 NFIs amounting to ₱40,329,124.88 are prepositioned in various Local Government Units (LGUs) across the region.
- The DSWD FO II attended the Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) convened by the Office of the Civil Defense Field Office II (OCD FO II);
- Regional Quick Response Teams (RQRTs), Social Welfare and Development Teams (SWADTs) and City/Municipal Action Teams (C/MATs) in the region are on ON-CALL/STANDBY status for any concern that needs to be addressed by the Field Office; and
- Ensured availability of Food and Non-Food Items

Department of Public Works and Highways Region 2

- Implemented “Lakbay Alalay” program for motorist assistance station for the celebration of Lenten season 2024 with the composition of Motorist Assistance Teams and a map showing the location of identified stations in region 2.
- Coordinated with LTO, PNP, Officials of the Local Government Units.
- District Engineering Offices with on-going projects along national roads, proper coordination with the concerned contractors were undertaken for the scheduling of their road works and the installation of necessary traffic advisory.

Philippine National Police Region 2

- Deployed PNP Personnel to places of worship, places of convergence during the Semana Santa period, and major thoroughfares.
- Intensity checkpoint operations to ensure safety and security of all commuters:
- Maximize the deployment of personnel especially to churches, pilgrim sites, terminals, and other places of convergence to ensure the safety of tourist and general public:
- Mobilize Force Multipliers in the implementation of ordinances and in the regular conduct of "Oplan Bandillo"
- Enhance collaboration with other concerned law enforcement agencies, Local Government Units (LGUS), and private security providers and other force multipliers to prevent or minimize the occurrence of incidents.
- Coordinate with Local Government Units (LGUs) for the conduct of random inspection to business establishments and ensure the employment of lifeguards in beaches and pools especially in drowning prone areas.
- Conduct Red Teaming Operations in coordination with the RORRMC/PDRRMC for the Management of the Critical Incidents, and
- Provide traffic assistance in major thoroughfares, tourist destinations and other areas with ongoing road construction/rehabilitations.

Bureau of Fire Protection Region 2

- Increased Monitoring: The BFP intensifies monitoring and surveillance activities during Holy Week, particularly in areas where large gatherings or events are expected to take place. This includes monitoring fire-prone areas, commercial establishments, churches, and tourist destinations.
- Public Awareness Campaigns: The BFP launches public awareness campaigns to educate the public about fire safety and prevention measures during Holy Week. This may include distributing informational materials, conducting seminars or workshops, and engaging with communities through social media and other platforms.
- Emergency Response Preparedness: The BFP ensures that firefighting equipment, vehicles, and personnel are ready to respond to emergencies during Holy Week. Fire stations may be placed on high alert, with increased staffing and resources deployed in strategic locations. Moreover, the establishment of BFP F.A.S.T. (First Aid Service Team) in all municipalities will be observed which provides medical assistance to the public.
- Coordination with Other Agencies: The BFP coordinates closely with other government agencies, such as the Philippine National Police (PNP), local government units (LGUs), and emergency medical services (EMS) like PDRRMO, to enhance emergency response capabilities during Holy Week.
- Public Assistance Desks: The BFP may set up public assistance desks or booths in key locations to provide information, assistance, and emergency support to the public. These desks serve as points of contact for reporting emergencies, seeking assistance, or obtaining fire safety advice.
- Traffic Management Support: In collaboration with other agencies, the BFP may provide support for traffic management and crowd control during Holy Week events and processions. This helps ensure the safety and orderly conduct of religious activities and gatherings.
- Continuous Monitoring and Evaluation: Throughout Holy Week, the BFP continuously monitors developments, assesses risks, and evaluates the effectiveness of preparedness measures. This allows for timely adjustments and enhancements to response plans as needed.

This plan is based upon the concept that the emergencies will generally be parallel with their normal day-to-day functions. The same personnel and material resources will be employed in both cases.
- Strict implementation of Pre-Fire Planning and ocular inspection of public places such as churches, terminals, and other establishments where people gather relative to Semana Santa.
- Preparedness measures shall be undertaken such as but not limited to coordination with the LGU's and CDRRMO and MDRRMO's pertaining to Semana Santa, and inventory of assets and resources as well as personnel;
- Identification of deployment areas and resources to be utilized during the implementation of the OPLAN.
- Due to heightened alert, all applications for leave are under the discretion of strict consideration of their respective fire Marshals.
- All operating units are hereby placed on HEIGHTENED ALERT STATUS (Code Blue) effective 24-26 March 2024.
- All BFP officers and personnel in the City and Municipal Fire Stations on OffDuty status are placed ON-CALL.

Phase II – Response/Implementation Phase

- Continuous information campaign on fire safety and prevention at home and office through tri-media.
- Fire Trucks, EMS, and Rescue personnel visibility in strategic areas that can be easily available to the public.
- In the event that a fire occurs in the area, respective team leaders will report for augmentation of the working force.
- Coordination with other support groups, recording and documentation of events and to be submitted thru channel.
- All operating units are hereby placed on FULL ALERT STATUS (Code Red) effective 27-31 March 2024.
- All personnel in the City and Municipal Fire Stations MUST BE PRESENT to maintain vigilance and ensure prompt and effective delivery of fire safety/ rescue/ emergency medical services and relief operations.
- All approved leave applications are recalled and suspended except maternity, paternity and sick leave.

Phase III – Rehabilitation and Post-Implementation Phase

- Demobilization of resources will take place at this time.
- All stations shall submit consolidated After Activity Report [AAR] with documentation within 24 hours after the issuance of Normal Alert (Code White) to the Office of the Provincial Fire Marshal at bfp.minor@yahoo.com.
- FULL ALERT STATUS is hereby downgraded and lifted effective 01 April 2024.

- Reporting – Situational Report should be submitted every 12 hours (3am,3pm) using the given format. An After Activity Report also in PDF file format shall be submitted on or before 01 April 2024 thru bfp.minor@yahoo.com.
- Post Event Analysis – Issues and concerns should be duly noted and given immediate actions and should these issues require actions from higher office, shall be elevated through proper channel. All implementing units are hereby directed to observe the principle of command responsibility and ensure immediate actions to noted concerns.
