SitRep No. 1 for Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Mindanao (2024)

July 14, 2024 08:00 am

The Southwest Monsoon is affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao and was forecasted as follows:

11-12 July 2024

-The Southwest Monsoon brought moderate to heavy rains (50-100 mm) over Palawan, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, Davao Region, Misamis Occidental, and Lanao del Norte.

12-13 July 2024

-The Southwest Monsoon brought heavy to intense rains (100-200 mm) over BARMM, Zamboanga Peninsula, Sultan Kudarat, Misamis Occidental, and Lanao del Norte while moderate to heavy rains (50-100 mm) over Palawan, the rest of SOCCSKSARGEN, the rest of Northern Mindanao, Western Visayas, and Negros Oriental are expected.

13-14 July 2024

-The Southwest Monsoon will bring moderate to heavy rains (50- 100 mm) over Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, Northern Mindanao, Western Visayas, Palawan, Occidental Mindoro, and Negros Oriental.
