SitRep No. 4 for the Effects of Trough of TC FERDIE (BEBINCA) and Enhanced Southwest Monsoon (2024)

September 14, 2024 08:00 pm

On 11 September 2024, 11:00 PM, PAGASA issued Weather Advisory No. 1 for Southwest Monsoon. Per the advisory, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Masbate, Eastern Visayas, Surigao del Norte, Dinagat Islands, Palawan, Antique, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, and South Cotabato.

On 12 September 2024, 11:00 PM, heavy to intense rainfall were forecasted to be experienced over Occidental Mindoro, Palawan, Antique, and Negros Occidental.

Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Masbate, the southern portion of Quezon, the rest of MIMAROPA, the rest of Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Misamis Occidental, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, and Sultan Kudarat.

On 13 September 2024, 5:00 AM, heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Sorsogon, Masbate, and Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Batangas, Quezon, the rest of Bicol Region, and the rest of Visayas.

On 13 September 2024, 6:00 PM, Tropical Storm Ferdie entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility. Heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, the southern portion of Quezon, Western Visayas, and Negros Island Region. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Zambales, Bataan, Metro Manila, the rest of CALABARZON, Bicol Region, the rest of Visayas, Misamis Occidental, Zamboanga del Norte, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, Maguindanao del Sur, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.

On 14 September 2024, 2:00 AM, TS Ferdie exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility. However, heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, and Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, the southern portion of Quezon, Bicol Region, the rest of Visayas, Misamis Occidental, Zamboanga del Norte, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, Maguindanao del Sur, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.

1. The Central Emergency Disaster Operations Center (CEDOC) is actively monitoring all weather systems to provide timely updates and disseminate critical information about STS Bebinca and Southwest Monsoon.
2. CEDOC ensures that the Early Warning System is fully operational and functioning correctly to provide early alerts and warnings.
3. CEDOC is consistently sharing weather advisories and updates on San Juan River water levels via social media platforms (Facebook and Viber) to inform the public, stakeholders, response clusters, and Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officers
4. All pumping stations are fully operational to manage and mitigate flooding
5. Emergency vehicles equipped with medical and rescue tools are on standby, ready to respond to any situation promptly.
6. Rescue boats are prepositioned and ready for deployment to ensure swift response and assistance during the storm and southwest monsoon.

DSWD NCR

1. Daily monitoring of weather conditions and other emergencies through telephone, internet, cell phone, etc. by the Disaster Response Management Division Staff and Quick Response Team Leaders.
2. FO-DROMIC Focal is assigned to prepare the consolidation of disaster reports in the event of 24 hours monitoring
3. The Quick Response Teams of FO-NCR composed of organic staff from the Field Office and Centers and Residential Care Facilities (C/RCFs) are activated and on standby in response to any eventualities. The assignment of said staff is scheduled per day.
4. If Necessary, the DSWD-NCR has established its EOC located at Room 109, FO-NCR, Sampaloc, Manila AND Virtual EOC of MMDRRMC via Zoom Call

OCD NCR

1. Activation of the Virtual EOC for STS Bebinca (I.N) and SW Monsoon, together with the Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) members.
2. Conducted Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment STS Bebinca (I.N.) and SW Monsoon on 14 September 2024
3. Continuous monitoring of the AOR for any untoward incidents

Mandaluyong City DRRMO

- Mandaluyong City DRRMC convened for a Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment Meeting to prepare and strategize for potential impacts of TS Bebinca (I.N.)
- Activate Emergency Operations Center in accordance with the alert level;
- Ensure 24/7 monitoring and coordination with regional and barangay DRRM council / committee;
- Provide information and warning to all stakeholders;

- Deploy search, rescue, and emergency response teams to strategic locations;
- Facilitate rapid damage and needs assessment immediately after the disaster.
