Trough of Tropical Cyclone FERDIE (BEBINCA) and Enhanced Southwest Monsoon (2024)

SitRep No. 6 for the Effects of Trough of TC FERDIE (BEBINCA) and Enhanced Southwest Monsoon (2024)

September 15, 2024 08:00 pm

On 11 September 2024, 11:00 PM, PAGASA issued Weather Advisory No. 1 for Southwest Monsoon. Per the advisory, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Masbate, Eastern Visayas, Surigao del Norte, Dinagat Islands, Palawan, Antique, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, and South Cotabato.

On 12 September 2024, 11:00 PM, heavy to intense rainfall were forecasted to be experienced over Occidental Mindoro, Palawan, Antique, and Negros Occidental.

Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Masbate, the southern portion of Quezon, the rest of MIMAROPA, the rest of Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Misamis Occidental, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, and Sultan Kudarat.

On 13 September 2024, 5:00 AM, heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Sorsogon, Masbate, and Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Batangas, Quezon, the rest of Bicol Region, and the rest of Visayas.

On 13 September 2024, 6:00 PM, Tropical Storm Ferdie entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility. Heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, the southern portion of Quezon, Western Visayas, and Negros Island Region. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Zambales, Bataan, Metro Manila, the rest of CALABARZON, Bicol Region, the rest of Visayas, Misamis Occidental, Zamboanga del Norte, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, Maguindanao del Sur, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.

On 14 September 2024, 2:00 AM, TS Ferdie exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility. However, heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, and Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, the southern portion of Quezon, Bicol Region, the rest of Visayas, Misamis Occidental, Zamboanga del Norte, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, Maguindanao del Sur, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Basilan, Sulu, and Tawi-Tawi.

As of 14 September 2024, 11:00 PM, the Southwest Monsoon was still forecast to affect some parts of the country in the next three days.

As of 15 September 2024, 8:00 AM, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 440 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (16.8°N, 126.4°E). Southwest Monsoon will continue to bring significant rainfall over western sections of Southern Luzon and Visayas. It will also bring cloudy skies with light to moderate to at times heavy rains over the rest of Southern Luzon and Visayas and the northern and western sections of Mindanao.

Status of Prepositioned Resources: Stockpile and Standby Funds

As of 12 September 2024, the DSWD FO MIMAROPA has a total response capacity amounting to ₱98,360,872.89. This includes ₱3,000,000.00 standby funds, 65,995 Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to ₱59,395,500.00, and 26,317 Non-Food Items (NFIs) amounting to ₱35,965,372.89 with breakdown as follows:
