SitRep No. 1 for the Effects of Southwest Monsoon (2024)

September 13, 2024 08:00 am

On 11 September 2024, 11:00 PM, PAGASA issued Weather Advisory No. 1 for Southwest Monsoon. Per the advisory, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Masbate, Eastern Visayas, Surigao del Norte, Dinagat Islands, Palawan, Antique, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, and South Cotabato.

On 12 September 2024, 11:00 PM, heavy to intense rainfall were forecasted to be experienced over Occidental Mindoro, Palawan, Antique, and Negros Occidental.

Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Albay, Sorsogon, Masbate, the southern portion of Quezon, the rest of MIMAROPA, the rest of Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Misamis Occidental, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Maguindanao del Norte, and Sultan Kudarat.

On 13 September 2024, 5:00 AM, heavy to intense rains were forecasted to be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Sorsogon, Masbate, and Negros Occidental. Meanwhile, moderate to heavy rains were forecasted to be experienced over Batangas, Quezon, the rest of Bicol Region, and the rest of Visayas.

Status of Prepositioned Resources: Stockpile and Standby Funds

As of 12 September 2024, the DSWD FO MIMAROPA has a total response capacity amounting to ₱98,360,872.89. This includes ₱3,000,000.00 standby funds, 65,995 Family Food Packs (FFPs) amounting to ₱59,395,500.00, and 26,317 Non-Food Items (NFIs) amounting to ₱35,965,372.89 with breakdown as follows:

a. Standby Funds

A total of ₱3,000,000.00 standby funds in the FO.

b. Stockpile and prepositioning of goods
