# SitRep No. 6 for the Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (2024)

### October 19, 2024 08:00 am

The Government of the Philippines partners with the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR) to host the next Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (APMCDRR) from 14 to 18 October 2024 at the Philippine International Convention Center in Manila (18 October is reserved for an optional site visit). The APMCDRR is the main platform in Asia and the Pacific to monitor, review and enhance cooperation for the implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 at the regional level.

The conference brings together governments, intergovernmental, international, national and civil society organizations, the private sector, science, academia and stakeholder groups to accelerate progress in reducing disaster risk.

As the first regional platform since the adoption of the Political Declaration of the Sendai Framework Midterm Review, the APMCDRR 2024 will be held under the working theme "Surge to 2030: Enhancing ambition in Asia-Pacific to accelerate disaster risk reduction". The conference will provide an important opportunity to review risk reduction efforts, share innovative solutions and make actionable commitments to accelerate disaster risk reduction by 2030 in the world's most disaster-prone region.

On 14 October 2024, 31 Ministers attended the Ministerial Reception and Marketplace launch at the PICC, the Art Exhibit opening at SM Mall of Asia, and courtesy call to the President.

On 15 October 2024, President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. led the Welcome Ceremony for the APMCDRR at the PICC Complex. Security measures were strictly enforced, leading to the closure of the complex's gates from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM to ensure the safety of all participants.

As of 15 October 2024, 3:00 PM, a total of 47 VVIP/HOD and 187 others have arrived/attended the APMCDRR.

From 14 to 17 October 2024, a total of 103 medical assistance and consultation were provided.

On 17 October 2024, Secretary Gilberto C. Teodoro Jr. of the Department of National Defense and Secretary Maria Antonia Yulo Loyzaga of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources led the closing ceremony of APMCDRR 2024 at the PICC in Manila.

As of 18 October 2024, a total of 46 VVIP/HOD and 90 others departed the country.
