SitRep No. 3 for Undas (2024)

November 03, 2024 08:00 am

All Saints' Day and All Soul's Day are celebrated by Filipinos every 01 November and 02 November of the year to pay respect to beloved dead relatives and friends. On this annual commemoration, locally termed "UNDAS", millions are expected to travel back to their respective provinces and expected to flock cemeteries around the country in observance of Undas 2024.

SPECIAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR UNDAS 2024 (30 October - 02 November 2024)

Tropical Cyclone (TC) LEON and its trough will be the dominant weather systems that will affect the entire archipelago during UNDAS,

On Wednesday until Thursday (October 30-31), Tropical Cyclone LEON will bring stormy weather over Cagayan Valley and Apayao, and rains with gusty winds over Ilocos region, rest of Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), Aurora, Quezon, and portions of Bicol region and Samar provinces. Cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rains will be experienced over Antique, Occidental Mindoro, and Cavite. Flooding and landslides are expected in low lying and in mountainous areas due to prolonged rains. Metro Manila, rest of Bicol Region, rest of Central Luzon, rest of CALABARZON, rest of MIMAROPA, rest of Western Visayas, Negros Island Region (NIR), and Zamboanga Peninsula will be cloudy with scattered rains and thunderstorms. The rest of the country will have partly cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms mostly in the afternoon or evening.

On Friday (November 1), Occidental Mindoro will still experience scattered to widespread rains while Metro Manila, Ilocos Region, CALABARZON, Central Luzon, rest of MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Negros Island Region (NIR), Apayao, Babuyan Islands, and Batanes will be cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms. The rest of the country will have partly cloudy skies with the possibility of isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

On Saturday (November 2), Occidental Mindoro and Palawan will have mostly cloudy skies with scattered rains and isolated thunderstorms. Metro Manila and the rest of the country will be partly cloudy apart from localized rainshowers or thunderstorms.

Strong to typhoon-force winds coming from the northwest to southwest may prevail over Northern Luzon and the eastern section of Central Luzon. Moderate to strong westerly to southwesterly winds may affect the rest of the western and eastern sections of the country, while light to moderate winds over the rest of the archipelago.

First Aid and Medical Response

- -Set up first aid stations at strategic locations around the event areas.
- -Deploy a team of nurses, and first responders on standby.
- -Position at least two ambulances on standby for emergency transport.

Crowd Control and Traffic Management

-Crowd control and traffic management involve PNP officers stationed at key points, traffic rerouting plans around event areas, and clear signage and barriers to guide pedestrian and vehicle flow, including marked emergency evacuation routes.

Pre-Event Preparations

- -Conduct safety inspections and identify potential hazards.
- -Coordinate with local hospitals to ensure readiness for a possible influx of patients.
- -Install directional and emergency signage at event locations.
- -Test communication lines between agencies, volunteers, and local officials.

Bohol - Danao

One unit will also be tasked for the roving duties, two personnel will be stationed at the Operation Center and the other one unit will be on standby at Union port if in case there is a need to transport patient to Don Emilio del Valle Hospital.
- -Communicate with the Hospital to have standby nurses/personnel for the fast and immediate first aid when there is an accident.

PATIENT MANAGEMENT

- -Assess Patient- THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- -Rural Health Unit, if present will automatically do the assessment.
- -Should there really be an incident during the "Kalag-kalag" caused by the hazards listed above, the patient will be aided through the help of the participating departments specifically, the Nurse and the representative of Rural Health Unit. He/she will be treated with the tools and drugs that are readily available in the vehicle.

-If needing hospitalization, communicate and inform Command Center which will coordinate the RHU staff for the admission and transport of patient to nearest or preferred hospital.

TRANSPORT MANAGEMENT

-There are three vehicles available for the "kalag-kalag" celebration. One will be on standby at Poblacion cemetery, the other one will be on standby at Aguining cemetery and the other one will be on standby at Bonbonon cemetery. Aside from the three vehicles that are on standby, one vehicle will also be on roving. With the vehicles are the Personnel of the DRRM grouped into three with assigned leaders per station. -If there is an accident during the Kalag-kalag, these vehicles will be available for the transport of patients if he/she needs to be transported. The personnel assigned in that specific vehicle, will be the one to manage the

DRUGS MANAGEMENT

situation and will also transport the patient.

- Collaborate with the Hospital and RHU representative regarding the drugs that are available within the vicinity.
- -Coordinate with the first aiders as to the needed medicine or drugs when there is an accident.
- -Ensure proper packaging, storing and labeling of the drugs to be used so that there will be no room for error during the said activity.
- -Provide effective medication therapy management to the patient.

PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT

- -The Office of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management will be on full force during the duration of the "kalag-kalag". All personnel will be deployed in the said venue for the roving and monitoring of the situation. There will be 2 people staying at the office for the reception of emergencies and for other concerns related to the celebration of "kalag-kalag".
- -Wear required and proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in responding to incidents. No responder will be allowed to respond without PPE.
- -Maintain Situational awareness at all times and relay significant information to incident commanders.
- -Coordinate and collaborate with the PNP, BFP, RHU and Hospital representatives for the better and fast response to any hazard that may arise.

Bohol - Candijay

- -The Municipal EOC has been activated and is operating under BLUE ALERT status, ensuring real-time monitoring and quick response capability for any emergencies.
- -Key personnel are on standby 24/7, with communication lines open to coordinate with barangays and nearby municipalities if additional support is needed.
- -The SRR Cluster has been fully activated, with personnel deployed to designated health stations in all cemeteries across the municipality.
- -Each team is equipped with first aid kits, emergency medical supplies, and quick-response tools to address any medical incidents, crowd control requirements, or potential hazards within the vicinity of the cemeteries.
- -Health stations in cemeteries are supported by local health workers, providing immediate medical assistance when needed.
