SitRep No. 2 for TC NIKA (2024)

November 11, 2024 08:00 pm

On 09 November 2024, 8:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area east of Southern Luzon developed into a Tropical Depression NIKA. At 5:00 PM, NIKA has intensified into a Tropical Storm. At 11:00 PM, NIKA further intensified as it moves westward over the Philippine Sea east of Bicol Region. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 was hoisted over Isabela, Quirino, the eastern portion of Nueva Vizcaya, Aurora, the eastern portion of Nueva Ecija, the eastern portion of Bulacan, the eastern portion of Quezon, including Polillo Islands, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, and the northeastern portion of Albay.

On 10 November 2024, 5:00 AM, NIKA intensified into a Severe Tropical Storm. At 11:00 AM, NIKA maintained its strength as it moves westward over the Philippine Sea east of Quezon. At 2:00 PM, NIKA slightly intensified over the Philippine Sea east of Quezon. At 8:00 PM, NIKA slightly decelerated over the Philippine Sea east of Aurora. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 3 was raised over the southeastern portion of Isabela and the northern portion of Aurora.

On 11 November 2024 at 5:00 AM, NIKA intensified into a Typhoon over the sea east of Aurora. Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 4 was hoisted. At 8:10 AM, based on all available data including from Baler Weather Radar, the center of the eye of Typhoon NIKA (TORAJI) has made landfall in the vicinity of Dilasag, Aurora and now traversing Northern Luzon. At 2:00 PM, NIKA is over Cordillera Administrative Region.

Luzon: The northwestern and eastern portions of Cagayan (Iguig, Peñablanca, Baggao, Alcalá, Amulung, Santo Niño, Gattaran, Lasam, Santa Praxedes, Claveria, Sanchez-Mira, Pamplona, Abulug, Allacapan, Ballesteros, Lal-Lo, Aparri, Camalaniugan, Buguey, Santa Teresita, Gonzaga), the rest of Isabela, the rest of Nueva Vizcaya, the rest of Quirino, the rest of Apayao, the rest of Benguet, the rest of Ilocos Norte, La Union, the northeastern portion of Pangasinan (San Nicolas, Natividad, San Quintin, Sison, San Manuel, Umingan, Tayug), the northern and central portions of Aurora (Dipaculao, Maria Aurora, Baler, Dilasag, Casiguran, Dinalungan), and the northern portion of Nueva Ecija (Carranglan, Pantabangan, Lupao, San Jose City)

TCWS No. 1 Wind threat: Strong winds

Luzon: Babuyan Islands, the rest of mainland Cagayan, the rest of Pangasinan, the rest of Aurora, the rest of Nueva Ecija, Bulacan, Pampanga, Tarlac, the northern and central portions of Zambales (Santa Cruz, Candelaria, Masinloc, Palauig, Iba, Botolan, Cabangan, San Marcelino, San Felipe, San Narciso), the northeastern portion of Quezon (General Nakar) including Pollilo Islands

- All Disaster Response of CSWDD personnel are on standby, modular tents in 16 barangays are available. food and non-food items are on standby.
- Philippine National Police - Parañaque Central Police Station and mobile patrol teams are on standby alert for any untoward incidents.
- Bureau of Fire Protection- Parañaque Central Fire Station is on standby and conducted Oplan Paghahanda Laban sa Sakuna (Paghahalasa).
- Medical teams of the City Health Office with ambulances are on standby for any unexpected incident. Medicines in 16 health centers are prepositioned and on standby.
- CENRO task force for standby de-clogging, mopping along DASA, Clearing and hauling operations. Booster Pump personnel are on standby.

- Personnel on standby for possible deployment / flood spotting
- Ospital ng Makati For employees and critical function holders who may not be able to report for work or may have challenge going to work:- Possible recall system to contact hospital staff that are within the vicinity to augment manpower- Provision of supplies and basic necessities for the current manpower- Arranging transport vehicles for incoming employees
- For the facility of the institution:- Preventive maintenance of the drainage and pump system of the facility and continuous checking of physical structure by the Properties Section of the hospital
- Since processes may be disrupted due to the effects of typhoon or flooding like power disruption, backup power of the generators will be directed to areas deemed to be critical or important
