OVERVIEW	On 23 December 2024, 5:05 AM, a residential fire was reported in Barangay Pag-Asa III, Imus City, and Barangays Gahak and Marulas, Kawit, Cavite. The fire originated from an explosion in one of the houses and quickly spread due to the predominance of light construction materials and strong winds at the time. Being located along boundary areas, the fire affected multiple communities under different local government units. The fireout was declared on 24 December 2024 at around 7:00 AM. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

Initial Report for the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pag-Asa III, Imus City and Brgys. Gahak and Marulas, Kawit, Cavite (CALABARZON) ACTIONS TAKEN

CALABARZON

OCD CALABARZON

- -Close coordination with Cavite PDRRMO, Imus CDRRMO and Kawit MDRRMO re details of the incident and status of affected population.
- -With standby non-food items (family packs, hygiene kits, malong and blanket) readily available for augmentation.
- -Coordinated with BFP IV-A and DSWD FO IV-A re the details of the said incident.
- -Continuous monitoring of situation in the affected LGUs.

DSWD CALABARZON

- -DRMD The FOs' EOC closely monitored the fire incident and assessed the immediate needs of the affected families.
- -The FO has conducted rapid needs assessment and visit to the evacuation centers as well as provided technical assistance to the LGUs relative to the management of evacuation centers.
- -Provided food and non-food items to the affected families in Kawit, Cavite.
- -Collaboration with the Local Government Unit (LGU) was established to ensure the long-term support and recovery efforts for the affected families.
- -The FO maintains close coordination with the affected LGUs for the updates on the internally displaced persons and for any request of technical assistance and resource augmentation.
- -Submitted DROMIC Report No. 1 re the Fire Incident.

BFP CALABARZON

-Responded to the incident and conducted fire suppression activity.
