OVERVIEW	On 6 December 2024, the Shear Line impacted the eastern part of Northern Luzon, while the Northeast Monsoon affected the extreme northern regions of the island. As a result, cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and isolated thunderstorms were experienced in parts of Batanes, Cagayan, Isabela, Quirino, and Nueva Vizcaya.

## ACTIONS TAKEN

### Region 2

#### OCDRO2/ CVDRRMC

- Continuous monitoring of the regional situation.
- Close coordination with Cagayan Valley RDRRMC member agencies and P/C/MDRRMCs.
- Continuous dissemination of weather updates/advisories and IECs to Cagayan Valley RDRRMC member-agencies, P/C/MDRRMCs, Media and other stakeholders through SMS, Viber, social media and Text blast system.
- Continuous monitoring of the major river systems in the Region and its tributaries to include the water sources from the Sierra Madre Mountains, Cordillera Mountains and others.
- Issued CVRDRRMC Memorandum No. 148 series of 2024 re: Maintaining the Blue Alert status at the Cagayan Valley Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operation Center ICOW the Northeast Monsoon and other Weather Systems
